Meeting on 2 May 2013

External Audit

5. KPMG issued the External Audit ISA 260 Report and the External Audit Report on the Quality Accounts with the recommendation to submit the ISA260 Report to Monitor in support of the Trust's Annual Report and Annual Accounts. The Finance Department is in the process of implementation the two recommendations deriving from the Report on Quality Accounts ('Off payroll' arrangements' (medium) and 'Agreement on Balances Exercise' (low)).

Internal Audit

- 6. The Audit Committee further received the following Internal Audit reports:

- 7. The Head of Internal Audit Opinion provided 'Substantial' assurance on 12 of the 13 reports issued in 2012/13. One element of the Key Financial Controls audit process only received 'Limited' assurance owing to the continuous delay in implementing the SAGE finance system upgrade. Subsequent volume testing of the system was successful and SAGE 100 has gone live on 17 May. It was agreed that a further Internal Audit report on key financial controls would be commissioned in the FY13/14, encompassing SAGE, from which the Committee could draw assurance.
- 8. Due to the tight agenda it was decided to postpone the review of the IT/Data Security Report which will now be considered at the Audit Committee meeting on 23 July 13.
