The Trust currently occupies accommodation in Melchett Road, Kings Norton, for use by pharmacy, warehouse and patient transport staff. The premises house the Trust's main aseptic unit as well as the main warehouse. The current lease is due to expire on 31 December 2013.
The Trust has negotiated a new 15 year lease, with a provision for a break after 10yrs, at a reduced annual rent of £378,000 (including VAT), a saving of £98,400 per annum over the current rent of £476,400.
Consideration has been given to other options including moving into alternative premises or into a new build, but these were discounted on cost grounds and issues regarding the feasibility of re-providing the aseptic facilities elsewhere.
Approval for execution of the Lease Agreement is a matter reserved to the Board by virtue of section 2.9.2 of Annex A of the Corporate Governance Policy
